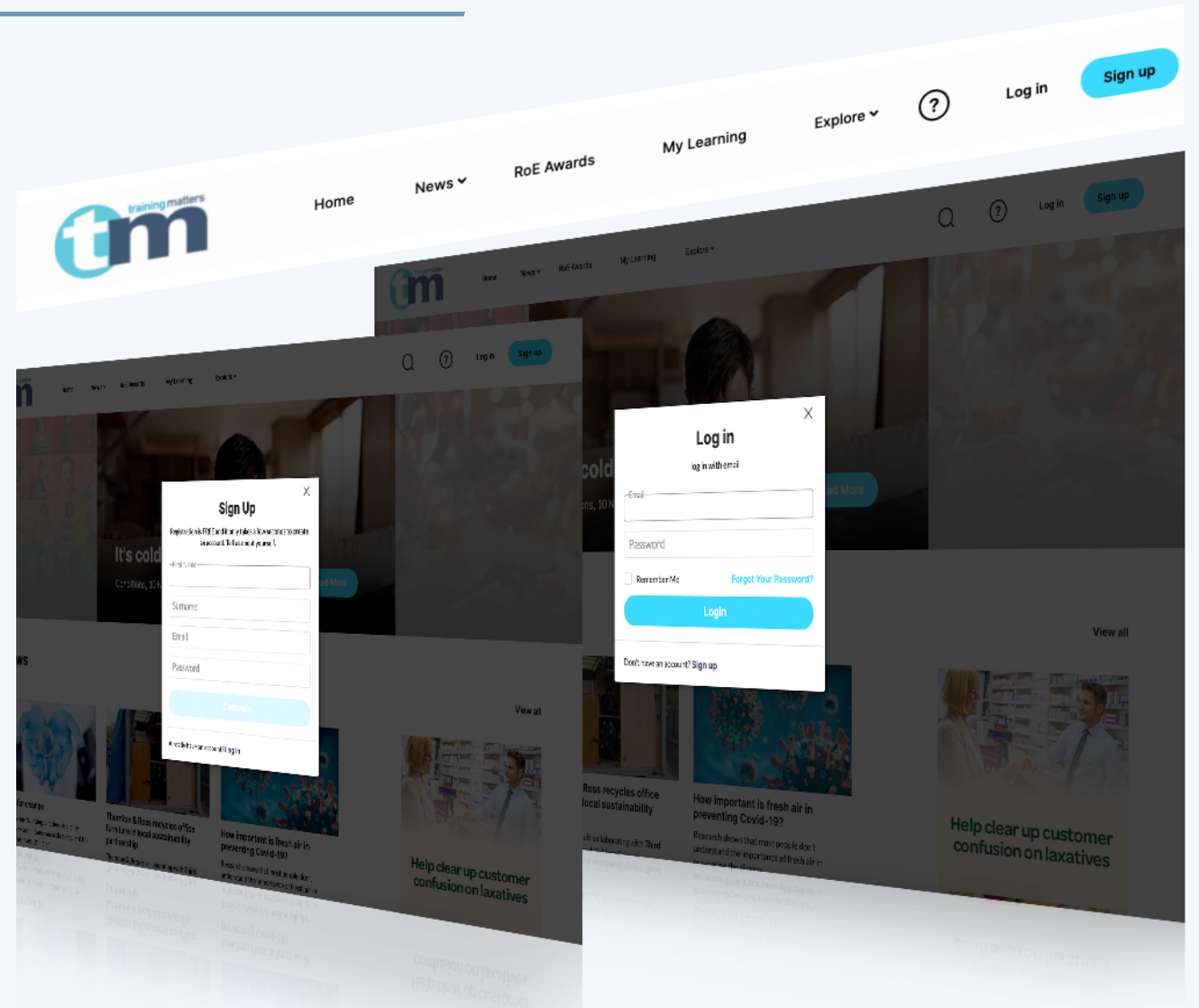

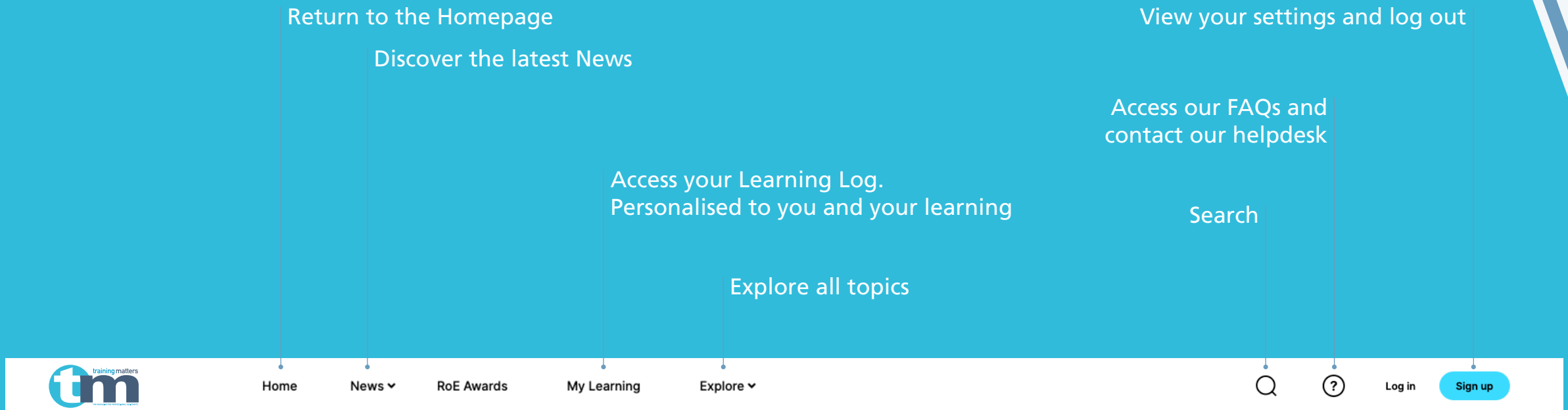

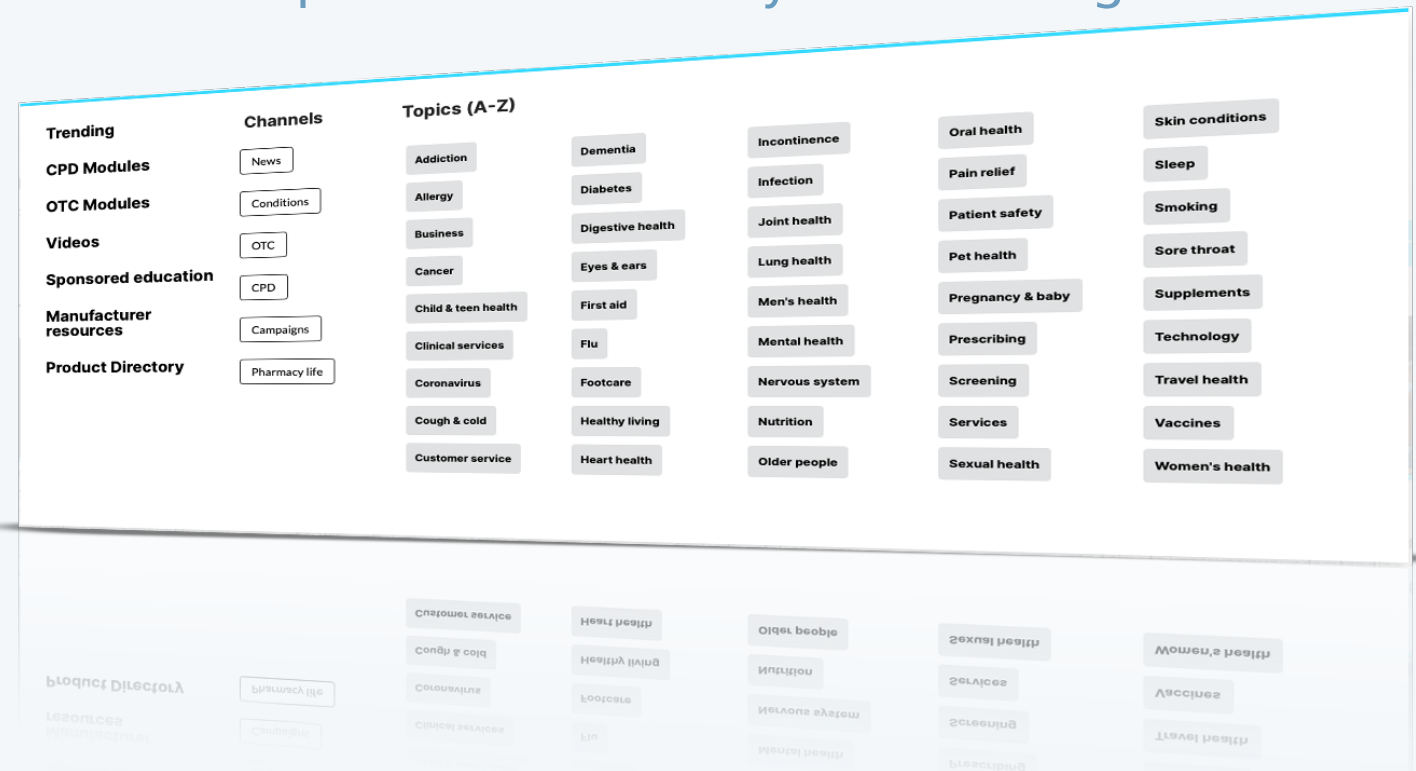


Navigation: Explore
